## 2009 Notice of Dues Definitions

### Member Family:

- a. Persons deemed to be within the family unit are the basic adult member (age 18 years or older), spouse or partner, his or her unmarried children, grandchildren, parent(s), minor(s) (under age 18 years) under legal guardianship or legal foster care, **all whose permanent residence is in the same dwelling**. Other relatives, summer house guests, full or part time employees, etc. are not considered as part of the family unit and are required to have their own membership certificate or pay an additional fee as appropriate.
- b. The Primary adult member is the member who will be first contacted in case of emergency. All mailed correspondence from KESC will be directed to this member.

### Summer House Guests:

- a. A houseguest is a person who **resides in the member family home for the summer** but whose permanent legal residence address is different. Houseguests are NOT individuals who live in the Cherry Hill area whose families are not members of KESC.
- b. A member family may sponsor summer house guests for the fee set in the Annual Dues Form. Proof of date of birth and permanent residence address of houseguests is required. Each application will be reviewed by the Board for final approval. A special ID card will be issued.
- c. House guests have the same age admission privileges as members.

### Child-Sitters:

- a. A sitter is a non-member, age 15 or older, employed by a member family to supervise the member's child/children, age 0 - 11 years.
- b. A member family may sponsor a child-sitter for the fee set in the Annual Dues Form. Proof of date of birth and permanent residence address of child-sitter is required. Each application will be reviewed by the Board for final approval. A special ID card will be issued.
- c. A sitter will be admitted as a child-sitter only while supervising and caring for the sponsor's children. The sitter may enter other times in accordance with the guest policies.

### Child Day-Care:

- a. A member family may sponsor a maximum of two non-member children under 12 years of age that are under their day-care for the fee set in the Annual Dues Form. For each child being sponsored under this provision, proof of date of birth and permanent residence address is required. A statement signed by both the child's parent/guardian and the sponsor family attesting that they are providing day care and the days child-care will be provided, must also be submitted. Each application will be reviewed by the Board for final approval. A special ID card will be issued.
- b. The child/children are allowed entry as day-care only with the sponsoring family, and only those days the parent/guardian is at work and must leave the child/children with the sponsoring family. Sponsorship can not be transferred. The child/children may enter at other times in accordance with the guest policies.

### Mid-Season Discount:

New Member families that join after the opening week are entitled to a discount on their membership dues. The discount is based on which week of the season the family joins and the number of family members. The discount is applied for the months of June, July and August. Contact the KESC Treasurer or Membership Chairperson to get detailed information on the discount.

### Delinquency:

Any member delinquent in payment of the annual dues, fees, assessments or other membership obligations by June 1<sup>st</sup> shall not be entitled to the privilege of membership during the delinquency. If payment of the established waiver fee is not made by June 15<sup>th</sup>, it will be made automatically by reduction of the value of the Membership Certificate and forfeiture of membership rights and privileges for the current year. The Membership Certificate must be re-paid in full for membership rights and privileges to be reinstated. If the Membership Certificate becomes reduced to no value (\$0.00) membership will be considered terminated.

### Waiver:

Members may waive their annual membership rights and privileges and still retain their Membership Certificate at full value by paying an annual waiver fee established by the Board of Directors. The established waiver fee is listed in the Annual Dues Form.

### Notes:

The full name, date of birth and permanent legal residence address for all houseguests, sitters and Day-Care children must be entered on the form.
